



Guidelines for Authors

Please read and incorporate all guidelines and formatting instructions before you submit the manuscript, and the author(s) should prepare their manuscript(s) according to the following guidelines.

Submission

- Manuscripts should be submitted only through the **conference management system (CMT)**.
- Should submit author details on a separate page. Use the "[Author Information Sheet](#)".
- **To facilitate the blind review process, remove ALL author-identifying information from the uploaded document, including the acknowledgements.**
- Submit the manuscript as a **Microsoft Word file**.

General Guidelines

- Manuscript must be written in **English** and **MS WORD** format.
- The **maximum page limit** for the full paper is **ideally 6 pages** including references.
- You should use **APA 7th style** for in-text citations and end-text referencing.
- Footnotes and endnotes should not be used for citations.
- The papers that are submitted to ICBI 2025 must NOT have been previously presented, scheduled for presentation, published, or accepted for publication by any other publisher or organization.
- Number each page of the manuscript.
- Papers that are not formatted in accordance with the guidelines given will not be reviewed.

Formatting Guidelines

- No. of pages : 6 pages including references & Annexes
- Abstract : Maximum 300 words
- Format : Typed in MS Word
- Language : English
- Paper size : A4

- Font style : Times New Roman
- Font size : 10 (Body of the manuscript)
- Line spacing : Single column, 1.0
- Headings : Refer to the sample article
- Keywords : Maximum 5 keywords
- Figures and Tables: Use 8 point, Times New Roman for Figure and table labels

Note: ***Please follow the same as mentioned in shared sample article.***

Use of Third-Party Material and Permissions Declaration

Authors are strongly advised to ensure that all content submitted in the manuscript is either original or properly credited. This includes the use of figures, tables, images, charts, and substantial excerpts from other published works (both print and digital sources).

Use of Third-Party Materials

If your manuscript includes material from third-party sources (e.g., published articles, books, reports, websites), you **must obtain the necessary permission** from the copyright holder prior to submission. This applies to:

- Reproduced or adapted figures or tables
- Quotations exceeding the threshold of fair use
- Any proprietary datasets or tools
- Material under restricted licenses (including Creative Commons licenses with restrictions)

All such materials must be appropriately cited and captioned. Authors are required to clearly identify reused material in the manuscript and provide proof of permission upon request.

Permissions Declaration Form

All corresponding authors are required to complete and submit a **Permissions Declaration Form** as part of the manuscript submission process. This form confirms that:

- The manuscript is the author's original work.
- Proper permissions have been obtained for any third-party material.
- All sources are appropriately acknowledged.

Failure to provide required permissions may result in **delays in the review process or rejection of the manuscript**. The Permissions Declaration Form can be downloaded from the conference website and must be uploaded as a supplementary file along with the camera-ready version of the manuscript.
