ICH 2025: Author Guidelines



Conference Tracks

1. Cultural Values and Identity

This track will examine how cultural values are expressed, preserved, and transformed through the humanities. It will address issues of cultural identity, heritage, and diversity.

2. Educational Values in Humanities

This track will focus on the educational role of the humanities in fostering critical thinking, creativity, and empathy. It will explore innovative teaching methods and the impact of humanities education on students.

3. Fostering Interdisciplinary approaches

This track will highlight the importance of collaboration between humanities and other disciplines to address complex issues from multiple perspectives.

4. New frontiers in Humanities Research

This track will aim on the future of Humanities research in higher education, adapting to a digital, globalized world.

5. Reconciliation in Humanities

This track will explore the role of the humanities in fostering reconciliation, healing, and understanding across cultural, social, and political divides. It will examine historical narratives, memory, and restorative justice in shaping collective identities and promoting peace.

Abstracts

Abstracts should not be more than 300 words.

Abstracts can be submitted in English, Sinhala, or Tamil. (Sinhala and Tamil abstracts have to be submitted together with an English translation.)

The title should reflect the focus of the study.

Include at least 5 keywords.

Include your name, affiliation, address, email, and phone numbers on a separate page.

Should be a block paragraph with no subheadings or paragraphs.

Abstracts will not be accepted via email.
